

SFARC JULY FOX HUNT

Saturday July 30, 2022

INTRODUCTION

Prior SFARC Fox Hunts were designed for teams to find 2-3 Foxes. This allowed teams to practice using their equipment and refine techniques to find the hidden transmitters. The July Fox Hunt is a contest – first to find the fox wins a new UV-5R (groups will need to decide how to split the prize – e.g. coin flip, rock-paper-scissors, pistols at dawn, etc).

THE FOX – hidden somewhere South of Downtown Auburn



- A plastic box w/W6EK painted on side
- Small vertical antenna
- Log in waterproof case
- Instructions to the rally point

- Fox will be on 146.565 MHz
- Transmitting at 25% duty cycle
- Participants should check in on the W6EK 2m repeater

FOX HUNT RULES

1. Participants will start searching for the Fox at 0930 PST (Fox will be off until start time) and will stop searching at 1300 PST.
2. Participants may start from any location (as long as the Fox can be heard).
3. Once the Fox has been located, the Participant(s) will record on the LOG attached to the Fox with:
 - a. When Fox was found in local time
 - b. Call Sign(s)
 - c. Go to the meet up location described in the Log
4. Log should be placed back with the Fox as originally found.
5. At 1300 end of the fox hunt will be announced on the W6EK repeater along with the meet up location.
6. At 1400 results will be announced!
