Create a very well organized, thought out swap meet that is inviting to both buyers & sellers.


Project Outline

- For 2015, We have decided to keep this a simple Swap Meet. There will be no extras i.e. VE, Seminars or workshops.
- Sellers spaces are going to be \$10.00 per space. A space is equal to one parking stall. Sellers that want two or more spaces will pay \$10.00 for each additional parking stall. Sellers fees are to be paid cash only.
 - Sellers tax forms with perforated windshield tag as proof of payment.
 - · Safety vests for staff
 - Flashlights with traffic cones
 - Cash Box

Sellers must pack out what they don't sell. NO DUMPING,

- The Club will provide a "Club Space" for members to sell their personal equipment. Free to paid club members.
 - Need two tables.
 - Tape or Tags
 - Cash box or envelopes
- Club will also offer paid club members 50% off (\$5.00) on space rental for their own personal spaces. Those rentals must be purchased in advance of event.

- The Club is going to "concession" Coffee & Doughnuts only. We will talk to Taylors & Loomis Cafe about food sales specials and maybe coffee supply.
