- 4 main lots
 - Blue Goose West, across from Hamfest
 - Blue Goose East, other side of Blue Goose
 - Loomis School, northeast on Taylor Road
 - City Lot, Walnut St. behind Post Office

- Sellers Park In Blue Goose West Lot across Webb St.
- Buyers Turn Right @ Taylor Road
 - Fill Lots in order above
- Disabled Parking @ Taylor's Back Log
- Overflow Street Parking If Lots Are Full
- No Parking in Taylor's Parking Lot
