## **Membership Highlights**

**Happy New Year to everyone!** By now nearly everyone should have received a renewal notice from Hamclubonline for SFARC if your membership is due. I am happy to report renewals are coming in at a faster rate than previous years. When you renew your membership, please take a moment to re-view your HamClubOnline account with the club for accuracy, including phone numbers. This is very important.

A couple of things about HamClubOnline. HCOL, is a volunteer organization that created this software specifically for the benefit of Ham Radio Clubs. They are volunteers who do this in their spare time for the free benefit of us and other clubs. It has been very helpful to a club such as ours, we have a moderately large and diverse membership, and there are few good software solutions, other than expensive commercial applications. They do have some hosting costs and we give a donation each year to them to help with this, but, it is much more affordable and keeps the costs of management to us down. So far, HCOL has served our needs very well and we are happy to continue with them. There are a couple of things that could help us maintain good service for members you should be aware of.

Multiyear memberships: Multi Year membership, the end date needs to be corrected manually. This is not a big issue, but, when you look at your account, please make sure your multiyear membership re-



flects the correct end date. I am testing out a new solution for next years. If you have any issue, please reach out to me via the help form at <https://www.w6ek.org/membership> and we will help solve any issues you may have.

Associate memberships: One of the features of HCOL is you can show relationships, such as family members. Each membership, in HCOL has their own account, including Associate accounts. That sometimes make it difficult to manage an associate dues. There are a couple of work arounds we can share with you if you need help with this, please feel free to reach out to us. There are possible solutions in the future, but it needs to be looked at further.

Now the positives!

- We have 348 active members in HCOL. (can you imaging manually managing memberships?)
- The Roster is at your fingertips! (only accessible to other club members)
- Your data is secure! (Your club account is protected with medical industry level security.)
- Voting for Club Business is recorded accurately and permanently.
- Club Inventory stored online.

There are many other features the administrators can use to manage the club. Bottom line, HCOL has been a tremendous help managing the club membership and useful for tons of other things. If you ever need help, please feel free to reach out.
